



INTRODUCTION DAY

This is an opportunity to have me come to your church and speak on a Sunday morning on one of the topics that the church might be interested in studying in the future. By preaching on the subject, the leadership of the church is in a better position to discern the leading of the Holy Spirit regarding my coming back to conduct an entire seminar. As the Lord leads, this one day introduction generates anticipation as the future seminar is planned and prepared for.

ONE DAY IMPACT SEMINAR

Hosting a one day **Foundation Seminar** is a high impact day for believers and a great first touch event for non-believers. It is an easy day to prepare for and promote because everything takes place during already scheduled times. Each seminar can be presented in a one day format.

Here is how it works: (e.g. Living a Compelling Compassion)

Bible Study Hour – How to Overcome Fear

In a joint Adult/Student session I will cover how we can overcome our tendency to seek self-preservation. It is our fears that keep us from sharing our faith. Developing intimacy with the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ are the central teachings.

Morning Worship – What Compels Me?

In a creative and humorous way I will explain how we can ask God to make us more effective witnesses for Him. The beauty of the Savior is presented and becomes a wonderful time of salvation for the unbeliever and of worship for the believer.

One hour prior to evening worship – Personal Accountability

In a fast paced meeting, different ways of developing personal accountability for witnessing are presented. Your current witnessing program (tool) is encouraged for all to participate. If you don't have a witnessing program (tool) in place I can

make suggestions that can be followed through on in the weeks ahead.

Evening Worship – Developing Compassion

Our Lord saw others with “compassion”. This is the missing ingredient in many churches that the Lord desires to place back within the church. This is the character quality that changes “programs” into “tools” by which we share the love of God. It is not the program but the love of God that makes the difference. The evening closes out with a time of commitment for all to repent and begin living lives that lead others to the Savior.

WEEKEND EVENT

A weekend event allows for more time to develop the themes of each seminar. With more time, questions and answers allow for a quality time of study in more of a conference atmosphere.

Here’s how it works. (e.g. Living a Compelling Compassion)

Friday night – Meal and opening session

The church will provide a meal for those participating in the weekend. Following the meal I will introduce myself and the conference giving the background for the study. This is a humorous and face-paced time that will encourage the hearers to participate in the entire study.

Saturday – Opening Sessions

On Saturday morning (9:00 A.M. – 12:00) I will teach the sessions on:

- Overcoming Fear
- Presenting Christ with Confidence
- Answering Every Difficult Question

By ending the sessions at 12:00 noon more people are prone to participate in the event. This way an entire Saturday is not involved. (However, if you desire to complete the conference on Saturday this can be done by taking a lunch break, returning at 1:00 P.M. for another two hours of study on developing compassion and personal accountability.)

Sunday – Morning Commitment Service

The message Sunday morning will be centered on developing compassion for unbelievers. The message is a challenge to those who did not participate on the weekend but also serves as a wrap-up for those who did participate. The message ends with a time of commitment to the Lord to become involved evangelistically in the lives of others. (Depending on the leadership of the Spirit, Sunday nights can also be utilized to continue the commitment of the church and the harvest of those who come to Christ.)

FOUR DAY REVIVAL

A four day revival service affords even more time for the development of the teaching and challenging the church. The format usually begins Sunday morning followed by four nights of teaching with a commitment service on Wednesday night.

LEADERSHIP WEEKEND RETREAT

For key leadership training a retreat is a tremendous opportunity for spiritual growth and renewed commitment. I can come on a Friday – Saturday and teach any of the growth material (especially the Becoming More Like Jesus material) during sessions in a retreat setting. These sessions would fit within the schedule of the weekend and culminate with a time of commitment on Saturday. Calendar permitting, I would be available to challenge the church on the following Sunday.
